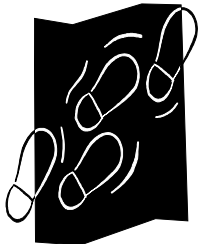
Who we are:

GOALS:

- Introduce the Bible as a special book and become familiar with simple Bible stories
