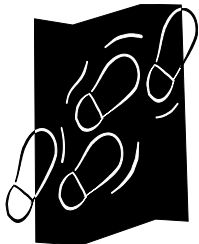
Who we are:

Curriculum

The 3s/4s program is for *three year olds* who turn four by Dec. 31st and includes:

- Daily religion, prayer and weekly chapel
- Large and Fine Motor development
- Language arts: Nursery rhymes, fairy tales, ABC song, uppercase letters of alphabet
- Math: numbers 0-10, colors, shapes & size, begin working on numbers 11-20
- Social studies: our community & the world we live in
 - Science
 - Dramatic play
 - Gym and outdoor recess
 - Story time
 - Show and tell and sharing
- Daily art, scissors and glue skills
 - Monthly cooking
 - Puzzle and book time
- Field trips & In-school programs
 - Special themed days
 - Snack

Additional Curriculum emphasizes:

- Social interactions: sharing, taking turns, play with others
- Comfortable separation from parents, comfortable transition from home to school
 - Self confidence
- Verbal skills: language and vocabulary appropriate
 - Following directions
- Learning routines and accepting change

- Self Control

- Becoming a member of a group and functioning in a group
- Independent skills, being responsible for personal "things"
- Courtesy in speech and manner
