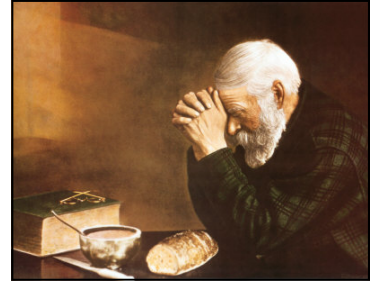

The Book of Ephesians “Need to Knows”

- Written by Paul to the Ephesians while a prisoner in Rome, circa 62 AD
- The church at Ephesus was founded by Paul during his third journey
- Acts 19 and 20 detail the history of this journey
- The phrase, “in Christ Jesus,” mentioned 27xs
- Ephesus was called the “bank of Asia” because of its great wealth
- One of the Seven Wonders of the World, the Temple of Diana, was in Ephesus; the city housed some of the world’s greatest art treasures
- Paul compares the church of Jesus Christ to a temple and will explain the great wealth that Christ has in His church
- A prominent theme: We inherit the wealth by faith and invest the wealth by works
