- I. It is about Jesus, and an event.
  - a. This is not about what you must do, or good advice, but about what has been done.
  - b. V2 It does demand a response.
  - c. Compare that to all other religions.
- II. It is about the fact that He died for our sins! We are sinful.
  - a. Sin is our most fundamental problem.
  - b. Sin=we don't live for Him.
  - c. “For” means on behalf of or in place of. V 3.
  - d. Some consider this substitutionary death primitive and “blood lust.” Instead it is egalitarian.
- III. It is about the resurrection.
  - a. It assures and secures our salvation.
  - b. You should want for this.
  - c. RB These passages serve as *footnotes*.
- IV. It is about Paul's personal testimony.
  - a. Grace humbles us.
  - b. Grace was not without effect-but is undeserved and unconditional.
  - c. Grace turns us into sacrificial livers of others.
  - d. Grace instills us with wonder.
