

## Moses Meets Pharaoh Ex 5:1-6:1-12.

### Chapel Bible Study

- I. Moses arrives in Egypt.
  - a. Moses and Aaron are accepted by Israel. 4:29.
  - b. Only Pharaoh was satisfied in this section.
  - c. **WHY** did things collapse so suddenly, and why the wrong expectations?
  - d. Perhaps this is “again no such thing as untested faith.”
- II. Was this a case of selective listening and **inexact** disobedience? Page 98,99.
  - a. Was it the “wrong delegation, wrong approach, wrong terminology and wrong request” (ie. moderate, limited and courteous request) that resulted in failure?
  - b. There is no such thing as untested faith. Do not think that trials are “strange.” Page 97.
  - c. The best example of course is God’s most obedient Son.
- III. God’s presence does not guarantee immediate results.
  - a. Think of OT examples. Abraham, ten years Gen 16:3, In Gen 17:15-19 and 21 God delivers on the promise the following year.
  - b. Such a delay followed the triumphant announcement of Gen 12:1-3.
  - c. But Abraham’s problems do not end with the birth of Isaac. He is told to do the unthinkable and sacrifice him. Gen 22:1-2.
  - d. The same could be said of Joseph. Gen 37:3,4. Is this how God blesses? Joseph is thrown in jail for remaining obedient to Him. In the end God’s ultimate purposes are brought into view. Gen 50:20.
