- I. Chapter 19, To meet with God
 - a. What the Lord has done v4.
 - b. What the Lord requires, our response of obedience v5a.
 - c. What the Lord promises, blessings which obedience brings, v5b, 6a.
 - d. Nothing must ever be allowed to upset this order.
- II. The decalogue- a covenant relationship, Deut 29: 2-4, 9-18,20
 - a. This is a series of sermons Moses preached which was the last thing he said.
 - b. The uniqueness of the covenant for which there is no modern word.
 - c. It speaks of a relationship more loving and more personal and more binding than our typical personal relationship.
 - d. Relationships in our modern society frequently all bow down to personal satisfaction.
 - e. Covenant Summary: "I will be what I should be whether you are or not." Both say this or it is exploitation.
 - f. Consumer relationship like with my grocery store are at the other end of the spectrum.
 - g. God only relates to His people in a covenantal relationship
 - h. However, there is a major, major theme of the Bible, repeatedly said. Judges 2:1, 13b. I will not forgive you if you break the covenant, and I will never forsake you. So, which one is it? Are the blessings conditional or not?! This irreconcilable tension propels the narrative. Clip 2-16:45.
