

**Who is the Lord Exodus 7**  
**Chapel Bible Class**

Introduction: Pharoah first received this message at 5:2. His reply begs the question, I have my gods, why should I obey yours? This ultimately led to the plagues.

- I. He is the unique LORD of all the world. 4:15-8:45.
  - a. The message is now presented by the “new Moses.” He is calm and fearless and a man of the word of God. Pg 113, v 7:6. Finland.
  - b. Why the plagues? These sent to underscore that “in the eyes of the Lord disobedience is as greatly abhorred as obedience is prized.” Page 114. (7:17) Q-Can you think of any other examples of circumstance where “the Lord gives a signal demonstration of how He feels and reacts” to disobedience.
  - c. The plagues will come “so that you will know that I am the LORD.” Pg 117. From v.(7:17)
  - d. The plagues will come “so that you may know that there is no one like me on all the earth.” Pg 117. From v (8:10, 9:14)
  - e. The plagues will demonstrate “that I might show you my power and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth.” (9:16)
