Exodus 13:17-14:31

- I. God's curious ways
 - a. For the Israelites, guidance was made easy.
 - b. God then led the Israelites south by the desert, not the main road north, directly to the Promised Land!13:17.
 - c. Then they were told to "turn back", with almost disastrous consequences. 14:2. (into a life-threatening trap) 14:9.
- II. How then can we/they be saved?
 - a. God saves by a decisive act! (an invisible warrior behind) 19,20.
 - b. GOD LEADS THEM OUT BEFORE THE LAW!!
 - c. How then were they/us saved? This happened apart from obedience from the law, and not by the quality of their faith!
 - d. They were saved by the object of their faith
 - e. He led them through the water, ie a symbol of judgement.
 - f. Noticed that they acted foolishly and faithlessly. 11,12
 - g. Moses acted beautifully. 13,14
 - h. He then received the rebuke they deserved! 15. Sound familiar? Hint: The angel of God.19. clip 32-38:40.
